Pan Pacific Masters Games Road Walk "That's a wrap legends!"

We did it, thank you so much to everyone involved.

The <u>10km road walk at the Pan Pacific Masters Games were held on Sunday 10th at the Luke</u> <u>Harrop Cycling Criterium Circuit, Runaway Bay</u>. Conditions were somewhat harsh for the competitors, officials, and volunteers alike with high temperatures and oppressive humidity. Comments had been received during the week from entrants querying why the race started so early (7.00am). Before they had even toed the start line, they understood why.

For some of the entrants it was a steep learning curve on the realities of race-walking competition rules. It was good to talk to some of the newcomers after the race that while being disappointed in being disqualified, they expressed an interest in having another go at race walking during our winter road walks and to try to master the rule conditions. We had some entrants miss the race due to event scheduling clashes in travelling between Brisbane and the Gold Coast and a couple of the overseas competitors had visa issues.

This event has taken many months to prepare with endless forms and compliance documents and three compulsory pre games sports meetings to attend on the Gold Coast. We must thank Pat & Maxine for attending the first two meetings on behalf of the club and to Noela who travelled down to the coast for the third meeting and to collect race equipment and accreditations.

It was a big ask of our members to travel to Runaway Bay in the early hours of Sunday morning to set up and officiate a road walk. But a big thank you to everyone who rose to the challenge and gave up their own time to support the athletes and the sport. Unloading and setting up started before 5.30am and there was a flurry of activity setting up the pergola, check in tables, laying out the yellow witches' hats setting up the water table. Thank you to all our club judges on the panel and to and Stan from QMA.

It was good to see former club members Nyle and Paul still going strong and back competing in road walking. Scott was first in the men's event and first finisher overall in 50.32. Kelly from Victoria won the women's race overall. Her winning time of 54.00 is a new W50 Games record beating the time of 57:27 set by Felicja Schmidt in 2002. Kelly is a world record holder at Masters level and competed for Australia in the 35km at 2022 World Athletics Championships in Oregon. Next finisher was Pramesh a regular Games stalwart from Victoria. Club member Brenda was second woman overall to finish.

For most previous Games we have enjoyed the hospitality of Pat & Maxine and a cooked breakfast they provided. This year, with Pat & Maxine enjoying a well-deserved overseas trip the club put on a light breakfast instead in the shade of the cricket club outdoor area. Thank you to Julianne & Noela for arranging the breakfast of fresh fruit, Subway sandwiches, muffins, juices, soft drinks and bottled water. The presentations of medals were made by Shane and Noela, official photos were taken and then it was time to say farewell to everyone until next time.

Thank you to everyone that made the conducting of this event possible and to those who assisted in setting up and packing up. These events don't just happen. It takes a team effort by group of hard working, dedicated, experienced and knowledgeable people to make it all run smoothly, compliant and safely. Special thanks to Ryan and the PPMG team who have gone out of their way to assist us and to the three enthusiastic Games volunteers. To Shane with his numerous hats as Race Starter, Head Timekeeper and Medal Presenter, to Stuart on the Check in desk and with the results collating, Andrew as the Recorder and Kai managing the water station. We also would like to acknowledge the support of the athletes who entered for this meet.

It was pleasing to hear some great feedback about our club and our wonderful members. Just as important we heard from athletes who said they had fun and enjoyed the morning. We are grateful to the President and members of the Runaway Bay Cricket Club for once again allowing us access to their facilities. See you back on the Gold Coast in 2026!
